Summer Term 2023 Academic Registration for Central Catholic Students

We are happy to offer our Summer programs for 2023! Students have the opportunity to achieve academic benefits like past summer classes.

Courses will be highly individualized programs consisting of sixteen (16) sixty (60) minute class meetings through the Month of July. Your instructor will coordinate where the class will meet in the building. This may change weekly.

- **CCHS students** have the opportunity to review materials AND improve final transcript grades up to a “B-”!*
- Summer Term offers **small, high individualized interactive classes** as in-person programs.
- Programs will begin on Monday, July 3rd and end on Thursday, July 27th. Classes will meet between 8:00-1:00 pm.
- **Tuition for these programs is \$300 per course***. While we normally limit summer work to two courses, in some cases, with administrative approval, students may attend three programs if we are able to accommodate those programs in our summer schedule.

CCHS SUMMER TERM 2023 PROGRAM POLICIES

- All students must be present and arrive in a timely fashion to their designated classroom.
- Please respect your teacher and classmates
- Dress code should be presentable and within CCHS dress down guidelines with respect to what is appropriate for class. Hats, hoods, sunglasses, and revealing or inappropriate clothing that references sex, drugs or alcohol are not permitted.
- Eating/Drinking while participating in class is not acceptable. This is distracting and inconsiderate of your teacher and classmates. Students who eat during a session may be removed from the class and progressive discipline will be enforced.
- **These may include suspension of remote learning and loss of program fees.**
- **Note: Students who consistently ignore the above may forfeit remote learning access and all paid program fees.**

Central Catholic Summer Term offers students the opportunity to attend courses during summer vacation: We realize that our schedule of courses might conflict with previous arrangements and family commitments. To allow for these situations, Central Catholic Summer Term permits students to be absent under the following conditions:

- All anticipated absences beyond one day must be approved by the director of Summer Term prior to the beginning of Summer Term.
- Students agree to make up all missed work and at least a portion of all missed class time. In most situations, students will make up all missed class time by arriving early or staying later.
- Students will be in direct contact with instructors via email as needed to fulfill these requirements.
- The Summer Term Office must receive in writing a letter from a parent or guardian with the dates of such absences no later than 1:00 pm on July 1st.
- **Extended absences not approved will result in loss of class credit, forfeiture of all fees, and withdrawal from the program.**
- All unanticipated absences must be accompanied by a phone call to the school by a parent or guardian no later than 8:00 am on the day of the absence.
- Upon a student's return the following day, the student must have a note signed by a parent or guardian explaining the absence.
- **Any unexcused absence will lead to a loss of credit, forfeiture of all fees, and withdrawal from the program.**

We ask that both students and parents/guardians review the above. These details outline the general expectation that our instructors address on a daily basis. Each teacher may have his or her own areas of emphasis so please be aware of what each class expects. Please be your best student and self during our time together.
